North Metro Fire Seeks Nominations for Board of Directors

Nominations due February 26; Election to be held on May 3

Northglenn/Broomfield, CO – North Metro Fire Rescue District seeks nominations from residents interested in serving on the District’s board of directors. There will be three at-large director positions up for election on May 3, with each position covering a four-year term.

Any interested candidates should fill out a “Self-Nomination and Acceptance” form, which can be downloaded from North Metro Fire’s website (www.northmetrofire.org) or picked up in person at the District’s Headquarters between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. All nomination forms must be filed by 5 p.m. on Friday, February 26, with the Designated Election Official Heather Brown at 101 Spader Way, Broomfield, CO 80020.

The three at-large positions are open to all eligible electors, regardless of where they reside or own property within the District. To be an eligible elector, candidates must already be registered to vote in Colorado pursuant to the "Uniform Election Code of 1992", articles 1 to 13 of title 1, C.R.S.

Additionally, electors must meet one of the following requirements:

- A resident of the District
- The owner (or owner’s spouse or civic union partner) of taxable real or personal property situated within the boundaries of the District (must provide spouse’s name if property is in spouse’s name)
- A person who is obligated to pay taxes under a contract to purchase taxable property within the District

North Metro Fire’s board of directors has five members who establish policies and set the annual budget for the District. The board usually meets the third Tuesday of every month at 5 p.m., with a few additional meetings held during the year for specific purposes.
