Looking for a great visual story this weekend? Check out North Metro Fire Rescue District's live fire demonstration at the Walmart on 10755 Washington St. in Northglenn as part of the District's fire safety fair on Oct. 10.

Two large containers set up as living rooms will be set on fire. One will demonstrate the speed at which a fire can grow and consume a room, while the other room will demonstrate how quickly sprinklers can put out a fire when installed in a home. Prior to the demonstration, a local resident will share her story of survival from being burned during a fire while she was at home.

The fire safety fair is being hosted in honor of Fire Prevention Week. In addition to the live fire demonstration, North Metro firefighters will teach families about the importance of smoke alarms, tour kids through an inflatable safety house and give fire engine and medic tours.

The event is free to the public and one the entire family will enjoy.
