THREE FERRETS RESCUED FROM PET SHOP FIRE

Broomfield/Northglenn, CO Firefighters from the North Metro Fire Rescue District responded at 1:09pm to a report of smoke in a business located at 575 Burbank Street in Broomfield today, where they found a small fire in a pet food store and quickly extinguished it. Broomfield Police Communications 9-1-1 dispatcher noted that a passerby called in to report the smoke coming from the building and “that the blinds in the front window are melting”.

The first fire engine arrived within minutes, and after putting out the fire, searched the building and rescued three ferrets from the business. The ferrets were unharmed and were later reunited with their owners.

The cause of the fire is unknown and remains under investigation at this time. Damage was reportedly minimal, and no one was injured fighting the fire.
